## **Scope of Work**

I will develop a website for Balanced Site Design. The goal of this website is to provide Balanced Site Design with an online presence and to provide current and prospective customers vital information about Balance Site Design's business operations.

The website will be a 3 page website consisting of the following pages: Home, About, Contact. The home page will have content and pictures as a welcome page for Balance Site Design. The about page will give a brief company history/bio. The contact page will have a form allowing customers to send an email to Balanced Site Design. All content and images provided by client. If stock images are needed client is responsible for fees associated with these stock images.

The design process consists of four (4) phases: Concept, Design, Technical, and Testing. In the concept phase, I will begin to work by outlining the basic flow and gathering text and images for the website. In the design phase I will create digital artwork for the outlined webpages and integrate the images and text. In the technical phase I enable the website server, domains and add interactive functionality like forms and emails. In the testing phase, I check the entire website to make sure it is operating as expected.

This website will work on all the latest browsers. It will be designed as responsive to operate on mobile devices.

Note: \*Due to slower JavaScript and DOM rendering engines, older versions of some browsers like IE8 may perform noticeably slower than other newer browsers. Older versions also are more likely to differ visually because of certain CSS properties that are not supported by the browser. However this is not likely for the majority of viewers whose browser updates are automatically downloaded and installed.
